The Heart of the Matter

God has a plan. God is at work. God is in charge. Three simple statements that reveal a grand truth: God is sovereign. He always has been and always will be. Have you forgotten? If so, then you need this reminder.

1. God Is Sovereign—What Does That Mean? (Selected Scriptures)

Saints on scaffolds often don't understand what it means for God to have a plan, to be at work, or to be in charge . . . but they should.

2. God Is Sovereign—What Does He Do? (Selected Scriptures)

Saints on scaffolds in the Old Testament and in the New Testament were never passive but were active in God's plan, active in His work, and under His charge.



Starting Your Journey

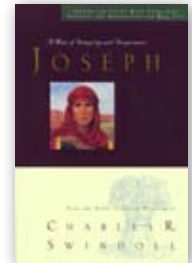

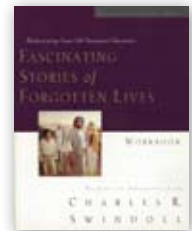
